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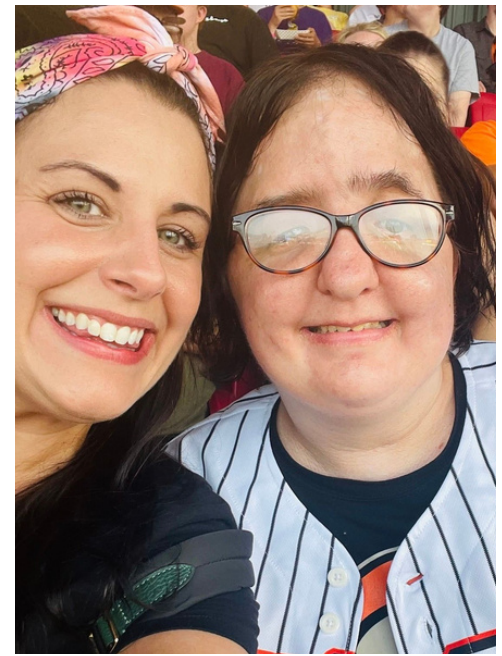
KICKBALL 2023

Luke rode a tractor with his grandpa and he also enjoyed a boat ride on the way to his family's cabin. What's better than a boat ride during a MN summer?!





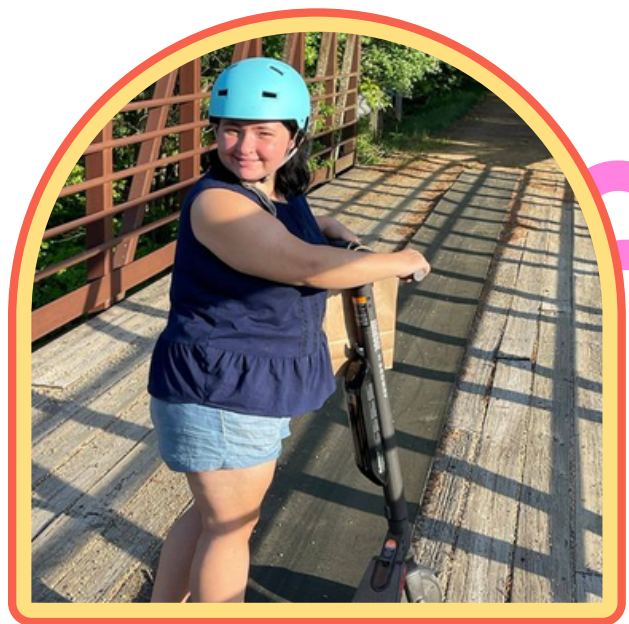
